





Approval of the National Nuclear Security Administration  
(NNSA) Fiscal Year (FY) 2009-2018 Ten-Year Site Plans

The National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Headquarters has completed its review of the FY 2009-2018 Ten-Year Site Plans (TYSP) for the NNSA Site Offices, Service Center, and Office of Secure Transportation. The results of this year's Headquarters review process indicate that the NNSA's final FY 2009-2018 TYSPs align with program planning guidance for Complex Transformation and meet DOE Order 430.1B, *Real Property Asset Management* reporting requirements.

Your FY 2009-2018 TYSP is accepted. The effort expended in developing this year's TYSPs was significant. Please extend our sincere appreciation and thanks to all who have participated and collaborated in developing this year's Plans.

As you know, the TYSPs are clearly planning documents. This year the Department will issue a series of Records of Decision (RODs) that will chart the future configuration of the Nuclear Weapons Complex.

The NNSA is promoting accessibility, accountability and openness in the prompt release of its TYSPs consistent with the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) and the Openness Promotes Effectiveness in our National Government Act of 2007. To this end, your TYSP will be posted to a public web site within 60 days of the acceptance date on this memorandum.

Again, our thanks to the many people, both at Headquarters and in the field who worked so hard to achieve completion of these Plans.
