A. Solicitation No. DE-SOL-0005982 for the NNSA Nevada Field Office "Environmental Program Services (EPS)" is amended as follows:

1) The Standard Form (SF) 33 block 12 is modified from 60 days to 180 days. An Offeror shall ensure that their proposed prices shall be guaranteed for 180 days from the date their proposal is received.

2) The final Request for Proposal (RFP) Cover Letter and Changes Matrix dated January 28, 2014 is replaced in its entirety with the Cover Letter (Revision 1) and Changes Matrix dated January 28, 2014. The purpose for this update is to correct that this acquisition is a total small business set-aside.

3) Section L, Provision NNS-L-2000, INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPOSAL PREPARATION - GENERAL (TAILORED) (OCT 2013): Paragraph (b)(9) is revised as follows:

FROM: (9) Page Count Exceptions. Every page of Volume II shall be counted towards the 50 page limitation, including attachments, appendices and annexes, except for the following: Table of Contents, Title Pages, Glossary, Staffing Plan Summary, Resumes, Letters of Commitment, Corporate Experience (Attachment L-3 and Narrative), and Past Performance.

TO: (9) Page Count Exceptions. Every page of Volume II shall be counted towards the 50 page limitation, including attachments, appendices and annexes, except for the following: Table of Contents, Title Pages, Glossary, Staffing Plan Summary, Resumes, Letters of Commitment, Corporate Experience (Attachment L-3, L-4 and Narrative), and Past Performance.

4) Section L, Provision NNS-L-2002, PROPOSAL PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS: VOLUME II-- TECHNICAL AND MANAGEMENT INFORMATION (OCT 2013): Paragraph (b)(1)(ii)(A) is revised as follows:

FROM: (ii) Underground Test Area (UGTA):

(A) The development and application of conceptual geologic source term and groundwater flow and transport models to aid in the characterization of deep underground contamination (700 to over 4,000 feet below ground surface) for radiologically contaminated groundwater in complex geologic settings covering areas larger than 100 square miles. This includes the collection and utilization of data to support the development of the models.

TO: (ii) Underground Test Area (UGTA):

(A) The development and application of conceptual **geologic, source** term and groundwater flow and transport models to aid in the characterization of deep underground contamination (700 to over 4,000 feet below ground surface) for radiologically contaminated groundwater in complex geologic settings covering areas larger than 100 square miles. This includes the collection and utilization of data **to define, develop, and implement the source term models.**

Paragraph (b)(1)(iii)

FROM: (iii) Radioactive Waste Acceptance: Conduct and coordinate facility evaluations and the review of waste profiles to ensure compliance with Waste Acceptance Criteria.

SCHEDULE OF CHANGES

TO: (iii) Radioactive Waste Acceptance: Conduct and coordinate facility evaluations and the review of waste profiles to ensure compliance with Waste Acceptance Criteria. Offerors are to assume 20 annual facility evaluations, 5 of which are audits and 15 surveillances, and approximately 180 waste profile reviews annually.

5) The Government hereby releases the first set of Question and Answers for the final RFP. Question #1-#8 dated February 6, 2014 are released under this amendment.

7) The Contract Specialist assigned to this requirement has changed her name from Krystal L. Maestas to Krystal L. Rodriguez. These names may be used interchangeably during the solicitation phase. However, the official contract documents will be amended at time of contract award to reflect Krystal L. Rodriguez.

8) All other terms and conditions to Solicitation No. DE-SOL-0005982 remain unchanged.
