DETERMINATION OF COMPLETION OF THE RUSSIAN HEU
AGREEMENT FOR PURPOSES OF THE USEC PRIVATIZATION ACT
OF 1996, AS AMENDED

Having considered the provisions of the USEC Privatization Act of 1996, as amended, (42 U.S.C. § 2297h, *et seq.*), and the requirements for completion of the *Agreement Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Russian Federation Concerning the Disposition of Highly-Enriched Uranium Extracted From Nuclear Weapons*, signed in Washington, DC on February 18, 1993 (the Russian HEU Agreement) with respect to and for the purposes of § 2297h-10a and as defined therein at § 2297h-10a(a)(1), and having employed the transparency measures and access provisions agreed to under the Russian HEU Agreement for monitoring the downblending of Russian highly enriched uranium of weapons origin, and having considered the Department of Commerce Determination of December 17, 2013, I have determined that not less than 500 metric tons of Russian highly enriched uranium of weapons origin has been downblended, and that the uranium derived from this downblended highly enriched uranium has been imported into the United States. Nothing in this determination shall be construed to alter, amend, modify, or terminate the Russian HEU Agreement or ongoing activities undertaken pursuant to it.
