

A. Solicitation No. DE-SOL-0005982 for the NNSA Nevada Field Office "Environmental Program Services (EPS)" is amended under Amendment #003 as follows:

1. Section I, is updated to include FAR 52.204-14, Service Contract Reporting Requirements (JAN 2014) by reference as a result of the FAR being amended to incorporate this requirement.

The clause reads as follows:

FAR 52.204-14 SERVICE CONTRACT REPORTING REQUIREMENTS (JAN 2014)

(a) Definition.

First-tier subcontract means a subcontract awarded directly by the Contractor for the purpose of acquiring supplies or services (including construction) for performance of a prime contract. It does not include the Contractor's supplier agreements with vendors, such as long-term arrangements for materials or supplies that benefit multiple contracts and/or the costs of which are normally applied to a Contractor's general and administrative expenses or indirect costs.

(b) The Contractor shall report, in accordance with paragraphs (c) and (d) of this clause, annually by October 31, for services performed under this contract during the preceding Government fiscal year (October 1-September 30).

(c) The Contractor shall report the following information:

(1) Contract number and, as applicable, order number.

(2) The total dollar amount invoiced for services performed during the previous Government fiscal year under the contract.

(3) The number of Contractor direct labor hours expended on the services performed during the previous Government fiscal year.

(4) Data reported by subcontractors under paragraph (f) of this clause.

(d) The information required in paragraph (c) of this clause shall be submitted via the internet at www.sam.gov. (See SAM User Guide). If the Contractor fails to submit the report in a timely manner, the contracting officer will exercise appropriate contractual remedies. In addition, the Contracting Officer will make the Contractor's failure to comply with the reporting requirements a part of the Contractor's performance information under FAR subpart 42.15.

(e) Agencies will review Contractor reported information for reasonableness and consistency with available contract information. In the event the agency believes that revisions to the Contractor reported information are warranted, the agency will notify the Contractor no later than November 15. By November 30, the Contractor shall revise the report, or document its rationale for the agency.

(f)(1) The Contractor shall require each first-tier subcontractor providing services under this contract, with subcontract(s) each valued at or above the thresholds set forth in 4.1703(a)(2), to provide the following detailed information to the Contractor in sufficient time to submit the report:

(i) Subcontract number (including subcontractor name and DUNS number); and

(ii) The number of first-tier subcontractor direct-labor hours expended on the services performed during the previous Government fiscal year.

(2) The Contractor shall advise the subcontractor that the information will be made available to the public as required by section 743 of Division C of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2010.

2. Section L, Provision NNS-L-2000, INSTRUCTIONS FOR PORPOSAL PREPARATION - GENERAL (TAILORED) (OCT 2013): Paragraph (b)(1) and (b)(9) are revised as follows:

Paragraph (b)(1):

(1) The Government will consider how well the Offeror complies with all solicitation instructions. Proposals, including any from subcontractors, affiliates and all teaming or other contractor arrangements, must conform to the solicitation provisions regarding preparation of offers. Failure to comply with the proposal format set forth in this solicitation may result in the elimination of the Offeror or material not being evaluated. To aid in the evaluation, proposals must be clearly and concisely written as well as being neat, indexed (cross-indexed as appropriate), and logically assembled. Proposal files are to be formatted in the following applications: Word 2007 or lower and Excel 2007 or lower for Volume III.

(9) Page Count Exceptions. Every page of Volume II shall be counted towards the 50 page limitation, including attachments, appendices and annexes, except for the following: Table of Contents, Title Pages, Glossary, Staffing Plan Summary, Basis of Estimate Log, **COCS crosswalk and subcategory descriptions**, Resumes, Letters of Commitment, Corporate Experience (Attachment L-3, L-4 and Narrative), and Past Performance.

3. Section L, Provision NNS-L-2002 PROPOSAL PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS: VOLUME II -- TECHNICAL AND MANAGEMENT INFORMATION (OCT 2013): Paragraph (b)(1) is revised as follows:

(1) TAB - 1: Criterion 1, Technical Approach and Staffing Plan Summary (Page Limit: 50 pages; however, the Staffing Plan Summary and Basis of Estimate Log do not count toward the page limitation).

TO:

(1) TAB - 1: Criterion 1, Technical Approach and Staffing Plan Summary (Page Limit: 50 pages; however, **Section (b)(1)(iv) deliverables to include the Staffing Plan Summary, Basis of Estimate Log, COCS crosswalk and subcategory descriptions do not count toward the page limitation**).

4. The NNSA hereby releases the third set of Questions and Answers for the final RFP. Question #1-#61 (includes the 45 questions previously released) dated February 25, 2014 are released under this amendment.

5. All other terms and conditions to Solicitation No. DE-SOL-0005982 remain unchanged.
