

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A. Solicitation No. DE-SOL-0005982 for the NNSA Nevada Field Office "Environmental Program Services (EPS)" is amended under Amendment #0004 as follows:

1. Section L, Provision NNS-L-2000, INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPOSAL PREPARATION - GENERAL (TAILORED) (OCT 2013): Paragraph (b)(3) is revised as follows:

(3) Each volume designated above, must also be submitted individually in FedConnect. Subcontractors submitting proprietary information may register in FedConnect and submit their information separately identifying in the subject line, the solicitation number and to whom they are a subcontractor; or they may provide a password protected document (file) to the Prime Contractor and share the password with the Contracting Officer. Regardless of the method chosen, the subcontractor's proposal must adhere to the proposal due date/time stated in the solicitation. Submission of electronic proposals via FedConnect will constitute submission of signed copies of the required documents. The name of the authorized company official shall be entered (typed) in the appropriate space shown on the Standard Form 33.

2. Section L, Provision NNS-L-2001, PROPOSAL PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS: VOL I -- OFFER AND OTHER DOCUMENTS (OCT 2013): Paragraph (b)(4)(v) is revised as follows:

(v) The Offeror shall complete the Contract Security Classification Specification (CSCS) form (reference Section L, Attachment L-10). Offerors who have either a Department of Defense (DOD) or Department of Energy (DOE) Facility Clearance must provide a DOE Facility Clearance code for themselves and all proposed team members/ subcontractors. If an Offeror, including team members or subcontractors, do not have an active DOE or DOE Facility Clearance at time of proposal submission they may still participate in the proposal phase, however they must comply with provision NNS-L-1009 for submitting an eFOCI package.

**TO:**

(v) **Section L, Attachment L-10, Contract Security Classification Specification (CSCS) form is provided for informational purposes so that the Offeror understands the clearance requirements in block 10 of this form. This attachment does not need to be returned with the Offerors proposal.** Offerors who have either a Department of Defense (DOD) or Department of Energy (DOE) Facility Clearance must provide a DOE Facility Clearance code **or their DOD Cage Code** for themselves and all proposed team members/ subcontractors **under Tab 3**. If an Offeror, including team members or subcontractors, do not have an active **DOD** or DOE Facility Clearance at time of proposal submission they may still participate in the proposal phase, however they must comply with provision NNS-L-1009 for

submitting an eFOCI package. **In this case, the Offeror shall provide confirmation that their eFOCI package has been submitted under Tab 3.**

3. The NNSA hereby releases the fourth set of Questions and Answers for the final RFP. Question #1-#66 (includes the 61 questions previously released) dated March 4, 2014 are released under this amendment. The answer to question #53 which was previously released under Amendment #0003 has been updated under Amendment #0004.

4. All other terms and conditions to Solicitation No. DE-SOL-0005982 remain unchanged.
