SUBJECT: INDIANA BAT QUESTION FOR THE TRITIUM TVA SEIS

SUMMARY

Dr. Arjo followed up with Ms. Holly LeGrand at TVA on a request by DOE headquarters on the status of Indiana bats at either the Watts Bar or Sequoyah sites. When the draft EIS was originally developed the Indiana bat was not listed in any of the 3 counties that the proposed action occurred in. Since that time the species has been listed in the counties as endangered. Dr. Arjo contacted Ms. LeGrand to determine if any surveys for the bat and occurrences have been documented. Ms. LeGrand said that there have not been any surveys for the species and that according to their databases and the county database there are not documented occurrences of the species. Ms. LeGrand asked if in the course of the NEPA documentation we had conducted a survey of the area, and Dr. Arjo stated that they had not. Dr. Arjo mentioned that the Watts Bar site had some limited forested habitat, and really none occurred at Sequoyah, and that the Proposed Action would not involve removal of any tree species which should eliminate potential impacts to summer roosting colonies. Ms. LeGrand recommended that consultation with the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency occur as well as with USFWS since the agency scrutinizes activities involving T&E species very carefully even if the species is not known to occur on the site.
