Subject: Record of Conversation between Marya Moultrie (City of Augusta Transportation Planner) and John Eichner (Science Applications International Corporation), Re: Status of Transportation Plans in the Augusta Regional Transportation Study

Date: August 10, 2010

The call was initiated by John Eichner to discuss the status of major transportation projects within the area surrounding Augusta, Georgia and Aiken, South Carolina. Ms. Moultrie confirmed that Phase II of the Palmetto Parkway project was complete as well as improvements along I-20 and I-520 in Augusta, Georgia. She also explained that the only major transportation project planned for the next few years was the expansion of the I-20 bridge over the Savannah River from four to six lanes. Ms. Moultrie explained that Georgia had set aside funding for this project and South Carolina was lining up funding. Once the funding was set construction would begin. She did not see any other major construction projects being undertaken over the next several years.
