During the Supplemental SPD EIS review session last week, a question came up in the discussion of Land Use in Section 4.7.1 regarding PDC/PuP support facilities. The PDC/PuP project will include four stormwater detention basins around the K-Area site in addition to the several support buildings. These stormwater basins and all support buildings are within the 210-acres that was evaluated in the *Environmental Assessment for the Safeguards and Security Upgrades for Storage of Plutonium Materials at the Savannah River Site* (DOE/EA-1538; December 2005). As we mentioned during the discussion, one activity under PDC/PuP is not covered under DOE/EA-1538, the sanitary tie-in at C-Area.

The routing for the sanitary tie-in has not been determined at this time but will run from K-Area to an existing lift station at C-Area – approximately two miles. It would be appropriate to acknowledge this activity for the combo project in the Supplemental EIS. It is anticipated that existing easements could be followed and there would be no change to the estimate of land disturbed. Prior to the construction phase for this sanitary tie-in, the SRS site use clearance process would trigger an Environmental Evaluation Checklist (EEC) to be prepared. The EEC process is used to identify any environmental concerns.
