

**Re: EIS data call - Accidents Since 2007**

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After additional review, the only accident at SRS since 2007 related to the conduct of activities at SRS similar to those that will be analyzed in this EIS is a plutonium puncture wound on June 14, 2010 in F-Canyon. A worker received a puncture wound that was contaminated with plutonium during a glovebox operation to assay retrieved waste drums for hazardous materials prior to repackaging for shipment to WIPP. The worker did receive a puncture wound and had tissue excised following the accident, did receive internal plutonium dose, and has been undergoing chelation therapy. There are no anticipated ill health effects. It did result in a Class B DOE Investigation, which is ongoing.
