<p>The U.S. Department of Energy, National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA), is holding public hearings in connection with the <i>Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement for the Nuclear Facility Portion of the Chemistry and Metallurgy Research Building Replacement Project at Los Alamos National Laboratory, Los Alamos, New Mexico</i> (CMRR-NF SEIS). The Draft CMRR-NF SEIS assesses potential environmental impacts of constructing and operating the Chemistry and Metallurgy Research Building Replacement Project Nuclear Facility (CMRR-NF). The CMRR-NF planning process has identified several project requirements that were not envisioned when the CMRR EIS was prepared in 2003. Facility modifications to address current nuclear facility design requirements, sustainable design principles, and ancillary and project support requirements have been analyzed in the Draft CMRR-NF SEIS.</p> <p>The public is invited to comment on the Draft CMRR-NF SEIS and potential impacts to the environment.
