Technology	Mainstream Support Ends	Extended Support Ends
SQL Server 2000	April 8, 2008	April 9, 2013
SQL Server 2005	April 12, 2011	April 12, 2016
SQL Server 2008 (and 2008 R2)	January 14, 2014	January 8, 2019

- **Each SQL Server version supported has a cost and schedule impact**
- **Tests must be conducted on platforms supported**
- **Discontinue LANMAS support of versions of SQL Server that are no longer considered within Mainstream Support by Microsoft**

Technology	LANMAS Support Ends
SQL Server 2000	October 1, 2011
SQL Server 2005	October 1, 2012
SQL Server 2008 (and 2008 R2)	To Be Determined

Proposed Technology Transfer Changes

- **Update the program sponsor to NA-72**
- **Define the support role and who funds the support**
 - Ordinary Technical Assistance
 - Special Technical Assistance
- **Define supported versions of the LANMAS product**
- **Add an Acknowledgement Sheet**
 - Signed by personnel requesting support for a site/facility
 - Include as part of the agreement

Proposed Technology Transfer Changes Cont.

- **Ordinary Technical Assistance includes...**
 - Eighty (80) hours of free support over term of agreement
 - *Additional hours must be approved by NA-72*
 - Assistance with initial implementation
 - Direct response regarding performance, functionality, or LANMAS production operation
 - Diagnosis of users reported issues with the LANMAS product, bolt-ons, plug-ins, etc.)
 - Resolution of problems or issues with the LANMAS product

Proposed Technology Transfer Changes Cont.

- **Special Technical Assistance**
 - Must be approved by NA-72
- **Includes..**
 - On-site Technical Support
 - Assistance with development of site specific enhancement applications
 - Support for obsolete versions of the application
 - Support for the application in a non-supported platform environment
 - Customized on-site training.

Proposed Technology Transfer Changes Cont.

Implementation Process

- The Technology Transfer agreement will be transferred to each site representative.
- The Site representative obtains the NMC&A Site Official and the NNSA/DOE NMC&A site official signatures
- The NNSA/DOE NMC&A site official transmits to Amy Whitworth for her signature
- Amy Whitworth signs and transmits signed copy to NNSA/DOE NMC&A site official and LANMAS Program
- Complete for all sites by July 31, 2011
