



Year (FY) 2011-2020 Ten Year Site Plans

The National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Headquarters has completed its review of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2011-2020 Ten Year Site Plans (TYSPs) for the NNSA Site Offices and the Office of Secure Transportation. Your FY 2011-2020 TYSPs are accepted. Please extend our sincere appreciation and thanks to all who have participated and collaborated in developing this year's Plans.

As you know, the TYSPs are clearly planning documents and do not necessarily reflect decisions or proposed decisions. Next year's submissions covering FY 2012-2021 will align with the 2010 Nuclear Posture Review.

Due to the frequent requests for the TYSPs under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) and to promote transparency and openness in Government, the FY 2011-2020 plans will be made available to the public. The TYSPs are also available publicly in accordance with the Stipulated Order in the case of Nuclear Watch New Mexico v. DOE/NNSA, Civil No. 06-221 BB/WPL. Your TYSPs will be posted to a public website within 60 days of the acceptance date on this memorandum.
