
Notifications





Notifications (continued)

- Each notification should include (if provided): Reference Number, Shipper name and address, Receiver name and address, end user, Stated end use, Expected Date of Shipment, Batch Number, Material Category, Mass, Physical Form, Chemical Form, Third Country Obligation, if applicable.


Obligations Accounting Notification Process







- New Members of European Community to be included in codes for Euratom, beginning May 1, 2004.




EU Enlargement


