NMMSS Training Course for NRC Licensees

NMMSS training for NRC Licensees is being planned for September 15, 16, and 17, 2009, at the DOE Headquarters, in Germantown, MD. The course is designed for individuals with limited experience in NRC reporting requirements and is based on NUREG/BR-006, Rev. 7 and NUREG/BR-007, Rev. 6. The following topics, among others, will be included:

- Completion of data forms: transactions, inventory and material balance.
- Inventory reconciliation
- Foreign Obligations reporting
- Report Products

The desired class size is 10 or less. A minimum of 6 will be required to conduct the class. You may register by contacting Ron Bonifay at (301) 903-6884, or by email at Ronald.Bonifay@hq.doe.gov. Resumption of Error Rate Reporting for FY 2010

In September 2008, the NMMSS program temporarily suspended (one year) the reporting of facility specific error rates. This action was deemed necessary as NMMSS was not only moving to a new software platform, but was also implanting new edit checks that sought to improve the quality of site-submitted data. The reporting grace period of one year was intended to allow both NMMSS and DOE submitters to be able to capture and implement software changes related to moving to a new NMMSS platform. Beginning in October 2009, NMMSS will once again promote the use of metrics by reporting DOE facility specific error rates. As in the past, feedback will be provided to data submitters, field/operations offices, and DOE program elements.

Since its introduction in November 1999, error rate reporting (and the associated initiative to reduce error rates) has resulted in dramatic improvements in the quality of the data submitted to NMMSS. For example, transaction error rates in early 1999 were double-digit at many DOE sites.

DOE initially set a goal for error rates of less than 5% and later in 2000 further reduced this goal to less than 2%. This effort was highly successful as evidenced by the fact that by the end of 2004, the average error rate for DOE facilities was below 1%.



REPORTING CLARIFICATION!





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

IMPORTANT: The “DO NOT X-RAY” marking does not prevent incoming packages from being sanitized. Please package CDs in cardboard rather than plastic casings.
