Ed, I have a few questions in reference to the attached FY2009 table you sent me 1-5-10 listing the electricity and fuel usage for NTS, RSL and NLVF in FY 2009:

- 1) Is it true - No Natural Gas usage at NTS? (table from 1/5/10 Ed Carr email says N/A) **As I understand the Nevada Power has no gas pipelines out to NTS so no natural gas usage on the NTS.**
- 2) In the FY2009 Table, there are listings for both the North Las Vegas Complex and the Nevada Site Facility-(part of North Las Vegas Complex). Are the quantities cumulative for NLVF, or is the quantity for NSF already included in the value for NLVC? (e.g. is NLVF total for natural gas 25,947 therms + 22,226 therms equaling 48,173 therms in total?) **Yes you should add together to get the total – they were split out as the meter these operations separately.**
- 3) The table indicates the Aircraft fuel is for RSL only, but I was under the assumption that RSL has no aircraft (just 7 buildings under lease from USAF) . However the NTS has the Pahute Airstrip, Desert Rock Airport, Yucca lake Airstrip, and Area 6 Aerial Operations Facility, and Helipads. Yet your FY2009 Table does not indicate any JP-8 jet fuel for NTS. Can you clarify this for me? **As explained to me by Roberto Reece and as provided by William Colucci the RSL Nellis Aviation Site Supervisor [(702) 295-8073] they operate 5 jet aircraft out of the RSL for remote sensing operations. The have no jet fuel at the NTS – the airstrips are available for other agencies on the NTS but unless they bring in their own fuel they cannot refuel on the NTS.**

Also, what should I use as the Reference Source for this information? **The information was provided by Roberto A. Reece, the Facility & Infrastructure Planning Manager.**

I'm still waiting for information on liquid fuel usages at RSL, NLVF, TTR as well information on the electrical supply systems as well as other data. If you happen to have any of this information, please forward.
