## North Mesa to Barranca Gas Line

**Did You Know?** DPU's projects are generally discrete from County projects because they are funded by utility rates, not from Gross Receipts Taxes [GRT]. They are engineered, managed and executed by DPU's in-house design staff and selected construction contractors.

### Project Description

Install 8,300 feet of high density polyethylene (100 psig) gas line from regulator station on North Mesa at Soccer fields on San Ildefonso road across the Rodeo Ground area and along the mesa, then down into Bayo Canyon and up to Barranca Mesa at Los Pueblos to a new regulator station.

### Project Background

The Barranca Mesa Medium Pressure Gas system has a single gas regulator station feeding approximately 600 customers. The 8" gas line will extend the high pressure system to the other end of the Barranca Gas System and the new regulator station will provide a second source of gas to the Gas System improving reliability.

### Project Schedule & Budget

\$820,000. Completion estimated for October 2011.
