The following revision or addition to the approved employment policies and wage and salary schedules of the contractor is approved as an allowable cost, effective **March 1, 2001**


Appendix A, Part II, Section B., Paragraph 4., Subparagraph b., (1) is modified to read as follows:

"(a) Honeywell Retirement Earnings Plan for Aerospace Employees at the Kansas City Division;"

Appendix A, Part II, Section B., Paragraph 4., Subparagraph b., (4) is modified to add a new paragraph (l) to read as follows:

"(l) Beginning June 1, 2002, a taxable income credit shall be provided to all eligible employees during the length of their employment under this contract. Eligible employees are those salaried employees and hourly to salaried transfers hired prior to March 1, 2001 who are employed under the contract on June 1, 2002. This credit shall be given to offset the elimination of the Long-Term Disability benefit effective June 1, 2002 that was once provided under the pension program. This credit shall be calculated at \$0.43 / \$100 of an eligible employee's salary on May 1, 2002 and received every pay period."


