ABSTRACT

This report provides the U.S. Department of Energy, Nevada Operations Office with the documentation necessary to establish the Apple-2 Historic District on the Nevada Test Site. It provides a list of historic properties that contribute to the eligibility of the district for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) and provides contextual information establishing its significance. The list focuses on 15 sites consisting of individual buildings, structures and/or features or groups of buildings/structures/features that were accessible to the researchers. All 15 are considered to be eligible for the NRHP; most were built to study the blast effects of nuclear weaponry. It should be noted that this report does not provide a comprehensive list of Apple-2 historic properties as limitations by radiological control areas and a focus on the readily accessible properties precluded an expansive search. Thus, additional properties exist which could be added to the district on a case-by-case basis.
