Hello Dan,

I am going through the SEIS and I have a few comments for Thursday's meeting.

Update the maps - the LANL boundary has changed (specifically the Airport, the old LASO building, and tract A-13 have all been conveyed to the county as has a section of SR 4 in White Rock) and the maps in Chapters 1 and 3 do not reflect these changes (I attached a recent map - although the White Rock Tract does not appear as conveyed).

In Chapter 3, note that the Land Conveyance and Transfer Project has been extended until 2022 and cited the Land Conveyance and Transfer EIS.

Chapter 3 "The conveyance and transfer of land has resulted in the removal of some archaeological sites from DOE protection. However, archaeological protection easements have been used to provide continued protection for many of these sites (DOE 2008:4-127)." This is a little misleading, sites situated on lands to be conveyed to Los Alamos county for economic development were excavated and therefore mitigated under the Programmatic Agreement not removed from protection - should cite the Land Conveyance and Transfer Project EIS and the Report (LA-UR-07-6205).

The size of LANL has changed it is now I think

37 sq miles not 40 sq miles and in Chapter 1 it states that there are 47 TAs and in Chapter 3 it says 48.

The SWEIS is mentioned in the text, it is not included in the reference section of Chapter 1.

Hope this is helpful and not nitpicky.
