Thank you for the responses regarding land transfer. But now, I think I need a secret decoder ring. The October 2010 map has a table (bottom left) showing the tracts that have been, will be, and won't be transferred/conveyed. But simply adding the number of tracts in each category doesn't align with Jen's answer below. I assume that some of these are considered a single entity in Jen's numbers, but split out in the detail provided in the map.
