**TERRI SLACK NAMED SITE COUNSEL
FOR NNSA'S Y-12 SITE OFFICE**

OAK RIDGE, Tenn. – Terri Slack has been named Site Counsel for the National Nuclear Security Administration's Y-12 Site Office.

In her new position, Slack will be responsible for providing legal counsel to the Y-12 Site Office and will oversee legal activities at the Y-12 National Security Complex.

Slack has been an employee of the Department of Energy for over 20 years, previously serving as counsel with the Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) Office of Chief Counsel. In her previous position, Slack served as counsel to the ORO Office of Nuclear Fuel Supply and most recently was responsible for legal matters involving the United States Enrichment Corporation at the Paducah and Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plants.

Slack received a B.S. degree in secondary education in 1980 and a doctor of jurisprudence in 1983, both from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville.

Slack is a member of the West Lake Church and supports activities with the Susan B. Komen Foundation Race for the Cure, A.L. Lotts Elementary School and West Valley Middle School. She and husband Jeff have three children: Jeffrey (16); Betsy (13); and Thomas (10).
